

**POLICY 200.1-
ELIGIBLE COURSES OFFERINGS POLICY FOR NON-RESIDENT LEARNERS
THROUGH DISTRIBUTED LEARNING**

1. Non-Resident Learners may take the following courses through means of distributed learning to be counted toward the B.C. Graduation Program:
 - 1.1. A maximum of 24 credits in total that (may be drawn from any course with the exception of English 11, English 12 and Social Studies 10, 11 and 12.
 - 1.2. A maximum of 8 credits may be taken at the Grade 10 level (and a maximum of 4 credits of English Language Arts 10).
 - 1.3. No more than 16 credits may be drawn from the Grade 11 and Grade 12 levels.
2. A maximum of 16 of these credits at the Grade 11 and Grade 12 levels (and a maximum of 12 credits at the Grade 12 level with only 4 credits from outside Math and Science courses).
 - 2.1. Within the eligible course offerings identified in the course offerings, learners may not take the following by means of distributed learning to be counted toward the B.C. Graduation Program).
 - 2.2. English Language Arts 11 and 12 courses
 - 2.3. Social Studies 10, 11 or 12 courses
3. School District No.73 Business Company may not offer non-resident learners the Graduation Numeracy and Literacy Assessments.
4. Awarding Credit for Distributed Learning Courses
 - 4.1. School District No.73 Business Company-Global Education does not award credit for distributed learning courses offered.
 - 4.2. Students may be awarded credit for distributed learning courses by their BC home school, as per the Equivalence and Challenge Process before credit can be awarded. <https://www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/education-training/k-12/administration/legislation-policy/public-schools/earning-credit-through-equivalency-challenge-external-credentials-post-secondary-credit-and-independent-directed-studies>
 - 4.3. The BC home school is responsible for awarding credit for distributed learning courses taken with School District No.73 Business Company, providing students successfully pass with a minimum of 50% as a final grade.
