2+1 Pathway Program to a British Columbia Education

- Students take two years of online courses in their Grade 10 and Grade 11 year while studying in their home country.
- Students complete their Grade 12 year in Kamloops-Thompson School District.

Students receive equivalency credit for online courses once they are enrolled in a high school in Kamloops-Thompson School District No.73.

Model of Instruction of Online Courses

- Teachers meet with students once a week for live video lessons.
- Students will communicate with the students via email, video lessons and other means of technology assisted learning.
- Students are supported by a TA at their home school.

Sample of Online Course for the first two years

- Career Life Education 10
- English Language Arts 10-Focused Literary Studies
- English Language Arts 10-Composition
- Mathematics 12 or Science 12 courses
