

AWARDING CREDIT FOR ONLINE LEARNING COURSES

Awarding credit for online learning courses are set out in this policy and is available on the Global Education website (globaled.ca) and may be subject to amendment at the discretion of the Ministry of Education and Child Care.

Procedures

1. Global Education does not award academic credit for online learning courses offered.
2. The Offshore School, Board or Independent School Authority are responsible for awarding credit for online learning courses taken with Global Education.
3. The Offshore School, Board or Independent School Authority may award credit for online learning courses and report final grades to the Ministry per the equivalence and challenge process.
4. Credit for courses that cover the Graduation Program that meet the graduation requirements can only be given by an Offshore School, Board or Independent School Authority following equivalency review by the Offshore School, Board, or Independent School Authority that the student is enrolled in accordance with the Graduation Program Order (M302/04) and applicable Ministry International Student Graduation Credit Policies.
